Associate Member - Any individual, firm, or corporation that is a media representative, a trade show organizer, or another trade association.

Membership Dues Schedule

Membership dues are based on gross revenues in U.S. Dollars and are payable on the honor system.

Membership year is May 1 through April 30. Membership dues for applications submitted January 1 - March 31 qualify for a 50% discount off the above rates. After April 1 dues are applied to the next fiscal year and 100% of the dues amount is due with application.

Manner of Payment of Annual Dues: Membership in SPESA is on an **annual basis only**. Annual Membership Dues are fully accrued on the first day of each membership year (May 1).
